 Ireland now of the County of Vericon, State of Georgia, being of sound mind & memory
 do make & publish this my last will & Testament. First, I request all my just debts
 to be paid, and then the balance of my property to be equally divided betwixt my
 wife Mary Ann and the child or children that she is now pregnant with should
 my wife Mary Ann decease leaving no issue then in that case all my property after
 paying my just debts, I give & bequeath to my well beloved Mother Mary Murray
 Duddaffsfort parish Wagon County, Downeagall Ireland for her own proper use during
 her natural life, then immediately after her death should any thing remain the
 same to be equally divided between my Brothers & sisters and in case of the
 death of either of them leaving children, that portion to be divided equally
 between them, and in case of the death of either Brother or sister leaving
 out heirs, that portion to revert back to the survivors & be equally divided between
 them share & share alike in the same manner as it would have been divided by
 the laws of Georgia had I died Intestate. I appoint George Newton & Har-
 borough Executors of this my last will & Testament. In Witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand & seal this thirtieth day of September in the year of our Lord
 Christian hundred & twenty six and the fifty-first year of American Independence
 Signed, Sealed published & declared by the said
 William Murray to be his last will & Testament in
