will and testament, that is to say, principally (and chiefly)
of all, I give and recommend my soul unto the hand
of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend
to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial
at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but
at the last general resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the mighty power of God.

As touching such worldly estate, wherewith it has
pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give some-
ise and dispose of the same in the following manner and
form: first I give and bequeath to Grandberry Robbins
my eldest son the sum of five dollars to be raised
out of my estate, and the balance of my estate after
paying off all my just debts, consisting of Lands etc
30000 Dollars then to be divided between my wife
Elizabeth Robbins and my children mentioned to be
Equally divided, at my death, between my dear
beloved wife Elizabeth Robbins and the Rest of the
lawful heirs of my body, and I do hereby, utterly, dis-
allow revoke and disannul all and every other
my testaments Will Legacies bequests and Execu-
tors by me in any wise before made, Willed and
bequeathed, Ratified and confirming this and no
other to be my last will and testament.

hand and seal this 23rd day of December in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and twenty eight,
signed sealed published pronounced and declared
by the said Arthur Robbins, as his last Will and
testament in the presence
of us who in his presence
have hereunto subscribed our names.
