the Same but Cautelling in mind the mortality of my body
and the uncertainty of Life do make and ordaine this
my last Will and Testament and a first and principally
of all I Recommend my Soul in the hands of almighty
God who gaine it and my body to its another dest it being
to be buried in a Christian like manner and touching
Such worldly Estate as it has pleased god to bless me
with in this world, I do give demise and dispose of the
Same as follows 1st I Give and bequeath unto my
Son Bolan Robert the following Negro Slaves (100) Ben
Cy Lion Rebeckah Lewis Solomon Sam William Selby Henry
Dick Amy Tom Monie Lizzy Sampson Markac Patience Jacob
Sobu Frank Ling Lucy together with all the future issue or
Increase of the aforesaid Slaves also all my land or real Estate
in Scriven County on Ogechey River where I now live
Containing three thousand four hundred and thirty acres (3430)
also one other tract of land in Floyd County in Said State
Containing one Hundred and thirty acres (130) together with
all my ready money Rights and Credits of every kind and
description whatsoever to him and his heirs for ever

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2 I Give and bequeath unto my Loving wife Sarah Robt
the following Property to have and to hold during her natural
life or widow hood to wit Frank Linabate Joe old Selby
Mary and Fater also my household (an Kitchen furniture to
gether with my manor plantation tools and implements
of husbandry also my flock of Cattle Horses Hogs and Sheep
but after her death or intermarriage which ever may first
take place all the property herebefore bequeathed to her for
the time aforesaid together with the future issue and increase
of the aforesaid Slaves is to go to and immediately vest in the hands
of my Son Bolan Robert and his heirs for ever

3 I Give and bequeath unto my Grand Son Hiram Robt
of west Florida Should he live to become of the age
of twenty one year all the Slaves that I have to my Son
John B Robt (100) Prince Paul old Fater Liza Mally
Anny and Cherry together with the Slaves (an increase of
the aforesaid Slaves from the time that they were bought
Should the said Hiram Robt Son of John B Robt
die before he is the age of twenty one year then I Give
that Can I Give Said Negroes with their increase to

My Son Bolon Robert (and his heirs (and said negroes to be under the Control & management of Bolon Robert during the minority of the said Heir and Robert)

4 I then I do hereby constitute (and appoint Bolon Robert Benjamin Phillips (and Elias Scarborough my Executors (and lastly I hereby do Ordain (and allow this (and no other to be my last will (and testament hereby Revoking (and annulling all former wills (and testaments

I James Corner of the State (and Coun
ty first written being of perfect
mind (and memory I do hereby Ordain this my Last will
and Testament that is to say first of all I Recommend to
the Earth my Body to be buried in Christian burial (and
as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased
God to bless me in this life I give devise (and dispose
of the same in the following manner

First I desire that all of my Last debts be first paid
out of my Estate

Secondly I give devise (and bequeath unto my Son John Corner
Five Dollars having given him already a note
that out of my Estate

Thirdly I give devise (and bequeath unto my loving wife
Ann Corner all my Estate both Real (and personal
consisting of Lands (and Negroes Stocks Horses Furniture
&c to have (and to hold during her natural Life or
widowhood for the Support of herself (and my Children
that may remain with my said wife (and it is my desire
that my said wife be permitted to loan any part
of my Estate to any of my Children that may be settled
or coming to themselves

Fourthly It is my desire (and I wish it so Considered that
immediately after the death or interment of
my said wife that all of my Estate be collected
