Item 3 I give bequeath and desire to my beloved wife Mary Sasser and to my lawfully begotten Children to-wit: Sissanna Daniels, Temperance Sasser, Francis Margaret Sasser, James Buist Sasser, Mary Ophelia Sasser, Elizabeth Augusta Sasser, Thomas Jackson Sasser and Eunice Sasser and to such other child or children as may be born hereafter to me all that tract of land upon which I now reside containing about twelve hundred acres be it more or less which said land is bounded by land of Lillian Sasser, tract lands of John de Miller for Hannah A Miller, lands of James Parker for Howell Sasser Jr, Venusky Peck and Allen Sasser and also all other real property which I may own or possess at the time of my decease and also all my personal property of whatever kind or character which I now own or possess or which I may own or possess at the time of my death to have and to hold, said real and personal property according to the laws and restrictions hereinafter mentioning, that is to say it is my will and desire and I hereby direct that my said wife who is the executrix hereinafter named and appointed shall keep all my property together and work and manage the same in the best manner she can for the use and benefit of herself and my said

believe, and that I will, well and truly execute
