the Land on which I now live joining Land
of Charles Stewart Patrick Buckle, Michol Fra-
volley and others at this time also I give and
bequeath unto my grand daughter above named

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Three cows (and three calves also one black mare also I give and bequeath unto my dear grand daughter Mary Ann Stewart all my Household and Kitchen furniture of all kind whatsoever:

Fourth I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter hereafter named a certain negro gal named Martha (and her increase the said negro & her increase to be sold by my Executor after my death and divided as follows to wit: one half of the neat proceeds of the said negro gal and increase to go to my grand daughter Mary Ann Stewart the other half of said negro gal and increase to be equally divided among my two grand daughters Sarah Ann Stewart and Elizabeth Stewart the daughters of Charles Stewart.

Fifth I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my friend Alexander Kemp Executor to this my Last will and Testament hereby revoking all others by me at any time heretofore made.

Place I now live on is about Nine teen (19) Acres
Joining; She is also privilege to clear any
Land on the Morton tract She is also privi-
lege to cut fire wood or any other Timber to
Keep up the plantation and Houses off of any
Lands that is now belonging to me; I also give
her a note on Henry Haupt (Brawn) in fa-
vor of John Woods for Sixty Five Dollars; All
of the above named Lands are to be only
to her benefit as rearing Repairing, &c. not
privilege to sell the Timber or cut it from
the Land for market her self; I do hereby
appoint Edward Jones and Noel Sanders
my Trustees and wish it understood that
they have power to act as such; And so as
to give that they may attend to the same
