others to me herefore made

First I desire that all my just debts be paid by executor hereof
named. Secondly I give and bequeath my slaves to my son George
W. and to my daughter Julia and to my son Harry all my
property which ever it may be, or where ever found that I am
possessed or may hereafter be possessed of in any manner what ever
Thirdly I hereby constitute and appoint my brother Peter M.
Stetson executor of this my last will and testament with full
power and authority to sell any portion or part of my property
that he may think will be beneficial or to the advantage to my
said heirs also it is my desire that my said executor shall keep all
my estate together without division until my said son of age
knows to mature age until my said executor should think in
his own judgment fit to do so, to my other two heirs their
distributive shares at their arriving at mature age but he
shall be invested with full power to use his own judgment in
regarding division that is before my son Harry becomes of age
if he may think in his own judgment proper
