appropiate for all men once to die do make and ordain this my Last will and Testame-
nt in manner and form following that is to say principally and first of all to give
and recommend my Soul to hands of God Who gave it and my body to the Earth to be
buried in a Christian like and decent manner at the discretion of my Executors who
I shall hereafter name nothing Doubting but I shall Receive the same at the General
Resurrection of quick and dead though mortals of my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
and as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me I dispose
of the same in manner and form following that is to say my Request is that my swam-
p Stock of hys one young Soverl house also all the Slaves now made both in the Swamps and
Hannah be Sold to the best advantag and money arising from the same to be applied
to the payment of my Just debts and Funeral Expences and the Remaining part of my
Estate both Real and Personall to be disposed of as hereafter follows to wit my desire is
that Edward Pye be paid out my Estate the sum of twenty five cents and each of the
rest of my Lawfull heirs the like sum of twenty five cents as their full part of my Estate
and the Remainder of my Estate to be Equally divided between Anna Kate Hedges and Elizabeth
Hedges Gill Hedges and Edward Hedges otherwise and there alike also my Desire is that
Hannah Hedges shoud live on and Enjoy the prively of my plantation whereon I now
live without Interruption during her natural life and take care of the few above named
children to wit his Mr. Elisabeth Gill and Edward Hedges and also to use any part
of my Stock not pointed out for the support and benefit of her self and the
youthful children and as her Declar the tract of Land whereon I now live together with
what of my Stock shall be left to become the property the named four children to be divided
as above directed and I do hereby appoint and ordain John Truman Junior my sole
Executor to see my Last will and Testament fully and truly performed in Testimony
whereof I have set my hand and Seal this second day of May in the year of our Lord
Eighteen hundred and nine

of Scriven being though the boundless mercy of God yet in extreme though weake in
Body yet of sound mind make my last will and Testament disannulling
Sciven Co. Ga. Will Book 2-B (1808-1879)
all other wills heretofore made by me and do request this to be Recorded as such therefore
first I recommend my body to the earth from whence it came to be buried in a
Christian like manner Secondly I request that all my just debts be paid and touching
such worldly Estates as it hath been please God to bless me with in this life I will
ana Bequeath in the following manne to wit First I will and bequeath unto my
Dearey beloved wife wingard Bonnell during her widow hood all the tract of Land
whereon I do now live all the plantation tools there ~~rest~~ of horses one half of the house
horses furniture my Stock of hogs thirty head of cattle that is to say eight cows and
calves the Remainder in young Stock cattle and four Negroes to wit George Isham
Siley and Harriet and at the Expiration of her widowhood ~~do~~ I request that the
said property be divided in the following manner to wit all that tract of Land as aforesaid
and the household furniture plantation tools Stock and horses as aforesaid to be
Equally divided between my two Grand sons Thomas Buylor Lovell and the
hins Lovell and the said Negroes to wit George Isham and Harriet then to be
property of the Said Thomas Buylor Lovell and the aforesaid Harriet then to be
the property of Eliza Maria Huis and Preston Secondly I will and bequeath
unto my Grand son Robert Wadkins Lovell three negroes to wit Jacob Nathan
and vice Thirdly I will ana bequeath unto them the aforesaid Thomas Buylor
Lovell and Robert Wadkins Lovell one set of mill Irons and one set of mill stones
which is now on the aforesaid land and all my Stock of Sheep to be Equally
