Walker considering the uncertainty of this mortal life & being of sound mind & memory do make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner & form following I give and bequeath unto www.georgiapioneers.com Elizabeth Walker all & singular the property both real & personal of which I have seized & possessed namely three Houses & Lots in the Village of Greenville, South Carolina & one unimproved Lot in said Village. Also three tracts of land in the district of Greenville South Carolina one known by the free school tract so called

conveyed to me by Wardsworth one known by the name of the Holmes tract & the other
called the Watson tract, all situated in the vicinity of Greenville Court House. One thousand
acres of poor land in the County of Screven & State of Georgia with the improvements thereon -
Also certain Negroes viz. Nelly, John, Sally, Robt, Little Robt, Robt, Little Robt, Peter, Smart, Mary,
Thompson, Charity & Ned. Also one carriage & thirty five Horses, and my stock of Cattle & Hogs, and
as is the rest, residue & remainder of my personal Estate, debts due me gold & silver of what
kind & nature soever I also give & bequeath the same to my beloved wife Elizabeth Walker, whom I
hereby appoint sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament, hereby revoking all former Wills
by me made. In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand & seal this tenth day of
November in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and twenty-three.
