I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
 without delay by my executor hereafter named as I am un-
 willing my Creditors should be delayed of their rights especially
 as there is no necessity of delay

Item Third

I give and devise to my beloved wife Milly with
 whom I have lived in the strictest quiet & love for a number
 of years my land on which I live No. Seventy Six containing
 One hundred acres more or less in the first district of Originally
 Pike but now Spalding which is a part deeded in Kentucky
 likewise all my farming utensils stock of all kind for the support
 of her family likewise the present growing crop and
 household and kitchen furniture for the support of the family &
 if any of the children should marry why then give them as
 much as I have given to the rest that were married & my
 money & notes and accounts after the debts is paid is to
 be for the use of the family & for my wife Milly to
 give for the benefit of the family all the foregoing property her
 life time & at her death all that is in the house is to be equally
 divided between Harrison my son & Emeline my daughter
 and Elizabeth my youngest daughter & the land to be sold & a
 equal division among all my heirs

Item the fourth. I constitute & appoint my beloved son Henry
 Manard my Executor to this my last will & Testament this 11th June
 1857
