Woodcock two negroes Eliot & Pelona to geth with ~~the~~ <sup>property</sup> I have here to give her which I Rate at two thousand Six hundred & fifty dollars Item 4<sup>th</sup> It is my will & desire & do give to my son Johnathan L. Mackey Daniel amant & Scott aboy to geth with the property here to give her which I Rate at three thousand dollar Item 5<sup>th</sup> It is my will & desire & do give to my daughter

Alice S. Holladay two negroes Pitt Sam amant & Ellen amant to geth with the property I have here to give her which I Rate at three thousand two hundred dollar Item 6<sup>th</sup> It is my will & do give to my son James P. Mackey three negroes Joseph amant & Tracy amant Louisa child which I Rate at two thousand One hundred dollar Item 7<sup>th</sup> It is my will & do give to my son

W. H. Mackey three negroes Bed amant Mary amant & Holland aboy which I Rate at two thousand One hundred dollar Item 8<sup>th</sup> It is my will & do give to my son Amos Mackey three negroes Amy amant Luanda amant & Charles the Child which I Rate at two thousand One hundred dollar Item 9<sup>th</sup> It is my will & do give to my son Thomas S. Mackey three negroes John amant & Priscilla which I Rate at two thousand Two hundred dollar Item 10<sup>th</sup> It is my will & do give to my daughter Malinda E. Item 14 I Give to my son W. H. Mackey M. A. Mackey P. H. Mackey M. E. Mackey W. H. Mackey all of my Beds Bedstead Bed Clothing One Bed Each divided Equal

Item 15 It is my will that all of my negroes not before mentioned that is Effellam Susan his wife Patience & ten young Children Susan & Child Lewis & Old Jack together with all of my land not before mentioned that is two Lots & a portion of the Down Place between said & Lewis seven acres the Cloud place & Lot # 5 or Call the woodier Lot and all of my Household & kitchen Furniture & things outside to be sold to the Highest Bidder & the Ready money buy them outstand
