to make my very last will and testament something all others here to fore
have made

Item 1st - I bequeath my soul to God who gave it and my body
to the earth of which it was made

Item 2nd - It is my will & desire that all my first debts be paid
by my executor hereinafter named

Item 3rd - It is my will & desire that after the payment of my
first debts all the remainder of my property both real & per-
sonal belong to my beloved daughter Catherine Hughes - And
I do hereby give and bequeath to my said daughter Catherine Hughes
all of my property of every kind and description whatsoever, that
remains after the payment of first debts as aforesaid

Item 4th - It is my will that my son Nathaniel Hughes be trustee
for my said daughter Catherine and that all the property herein
before bequeathed to my said Catherine be held in trust by said
Nathaniel Hughes for my said daughter Catherine and that
said property is not subject to the debts liabilities or contract
of any third party with whom the said Catherine may have
any - but that said property be used and managed by said
trustee hereinafter named for the support and maintenance
of the said Catherine and her child or children

Item 5th - I do hereby constitute and appoint Nathaniel Hughes
my before named son; the executor of this my last will
and testament
