Sturges, acknowledge ourselves, jointly and
severally bound unto their Honors the Justices of the Superior Court when
sitting for ordinary purposes for said County and their successors in the
past and full of four thousand dollars to the payment of which
will and truly to be made we bind ourselves and the heirs and
assigns of us and each of us jointly and severally by these
presents sealed with our seals and dated this twelfth day of
May 1836

The Conditions of the above obligation is such that
if the above bound Peyton Stynalds who is the day appointed
Guardian of the person and property of William Mc Gusharon
Orphan child of William Gusharon deceased in acknowledging
of the same by his acceptance of said appointment and of letters
of Guardianship of this date shall well and truly maintain
protect and educate said orphan according to circumstances and shall
take good and lawful care of his person and property according
to the laws of this state and shall annually make a return
in writing of all his doings and doings herein unto the said
Court then this obligation to be void else to remain in full
force - In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our
