memory and knowing that it is expedient for all
men to see do make and declare this my
Last will and testament in manner and form
following I bequeath my soul to God who
gave it and my body to the Earth from whence
it came trusting in the merits of Jesus
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ for a joyful

Item 1st I leave to my daughter Mary D. Dixon my

Item 4th It is my will and desire that my negroes Betty
together with my lot of land (number 92) money
two in the (16) sixteenth district of Lee County to
be sold and the money arising therefrom and what
~~other~~ money there may be on hand or owing to
me at the time of my death after paying all
my just debts be divided in such manner
as to give one sixth part thereof to the children
of my deceased son William Dixon and the
one sixth part to each of my living children

Item 2nd I leave to my daughter ~~William~~ Esters
my negro girl Emidy to be kept by her during
her natural life and at her death I give
and bequeath the said negro girl, ^{Emidy} to the children
of my ~~deceased~~ Ann Esters (including) her daughter
Evelina Asher, to be equally divided among them

Item 3^d I leave to my daughter Caroline Wott
during her natural life my negro man Grand
and after her death I give and bequeath my said
negro man Grand to my Grand son Saphy Wott
The said Saphy William Wott is to pay Nathaniel Wott
Turner son of Ann & Turner when he arrives
at the age of Twenty one years One hundred
Dollars of the said of the said Nathaniel Wott
Turner dies before ~~the said~~ money is to be paid
to his mother Ann & ~~Quincy~~

together with my lot of land (number 92) number

be sold and the money arising therefrom and what

me at the time of my death after paying all
my just debts be divided in such manner
as to give one fifth part thereof to the children
of my deceased son William Dixon and the
one fifth part to each of my living children
(that is) Harry Dixon Mary B. Turner Sarah
& Spruce Ann Esters & Caroline Wott

Item 5th I give to my Grand daughter Martha
daughter of Henry Dixon my Chest and an
pair of sheets

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my son daughter

Mary B. Scudder Sarah Spruce Ann D.
Estus & Caroline Holt all my best clothing to be
Equally divided among them and I hope and request
that this my last will & Testament may be satisfactory
to all my Children and that they may live
lovingly with one another while on Earth and
be prepared for Heaven when they die is the prayer of
our affectionate mother

And lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint
Nathaniel Holt and Francis Scudder my Executors
to this my last will and Testament hereby revoke
ing all other wills heretofore made by me and
declaring this and my intention to be my last will
and Testament I witness whereof I have
hereunto set my hand and bear this 21st day
