Item (1)

I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife Frances Jones all of my entire estate, real, personal, choses in action, money, notes, accounts, household and kitchen furniture, and property of every kind and description for and during her natural life, to be held by the following named individuals, Sons of Myself and Wife viz, - William B. Jones, Thaddeus Jones who are now of age - one twenty one years, and my Minor Son - Charles Jones so soon as he shall attain his majority - he being now in his Minority - for by them, or either of them, if in life, for the use support and maintenance of my said wife during her natural life, the title to all of said property to vest and remain in him, or either of them on and after my death, until the death of my said wife - for purposes above set forth and expressed

Item (2)

Upon the death and interment of my said wife, I desire and solemnly direct - and require that my said Sons in life - either one, or all three, divide my entire estate mentioned in item one - of this will, equally so near as practicable into as many shares as there may be Sons, or descendants of Child, or Children then in life, - the Child, or Children, of dead Child, or Children, to take in the place of deceased parent - and to

the same over to them with as little expense to them as possible - and when so turned over to them the same to become their absolute property, to do with as they may severally please.

Item (6)

My wife is named Francis J. Jones, and children are named as follows - Wm. B. Jones - Mrs. Mary H. wife of Jesse H. Jones - Mrs. Mary J. Johnson, wife of William Johnson, Wade H. Jones, John H. Jones, Sallie B. wife of Marshall - Leas, Cornelia Chapman - wife of Daniel Chapman - Mrs. Ida. Jones, and Mrs. Lucy L. Jones, each - and every one of whom are now in life - and to each of my daughters individually, I give their respective parts, upon death of my wife to be free from any present or future debt or debts of said present or future husband, and hereby appoint my said sons as trustees for them, individually, and invest them with power to carry out my wishes as herein set forth.
