Yalisco County } but knowing the certainty of Death and uncertainty of life
I feel Disposed to make some Distribution of what it has
pleased God to bestow upon me according to the herein after named
1st Item I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Rebekah Morris
all the Negroes now in my possession also the plantation west of the
Publick Road leading from Philipps Bridge to Crawfordville together
with the Stock of all kinds, House hold and Kitchen furnitures also the
Farming utensils of every kind also one tract of Land on the East
side of the above said road Embracing the Store house near
the Crook road the Last named tract to be at her disposal in any
way or manner also she has the liberty of selling any Negroes she
pleases and it is my request that they should Chose there masters and
go in family with a Credit of twelve months at Least

Item 2^d I give and bequeath to my Brothers and Sisters Children also
to my dear wifes Brothers and Sisters Children an Equal share
of what property remains in her hands after her death—with the
Exception of the first named tract of Land—

Item 3^d It is my request that after the death of my beloved wife that
my Nephew Alexander Morris son of John Morris have paid
to him the sum of One thousand Dollars as soon as it can be
Collected—

Item 4th It is also my request that after the death of my beloved
wife that Bro. B. Billingslea has the tracts of land whereon I now
live lying west of the Road leading from Philipps Bridge to Crawford
ville also that the said Bro. B. Billingslea have the sum of
Five hundred dollars

Therefore I Nominate and appoint my friend Thos. B. Billings
My Executor of this my last will and testament this day and year
of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and thirty two this twi
second day of November as witness my hand and seal
sealed and signed in the presence of
A. Norris
