

Henry A. Daniel's Will

In the name of God. Amen. - I Henry A. Daniel of the state of Georgia and of the County of Salisferry, being sick, and weak in body, and knowing the mortality of man, that it is appointed for all men to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and testament.

Item 1st my will is that all my Just debts be paid first.
Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved brother Epieon Woodruff my Youngest Colt. (and for it to continue with the mare till it is six months old,) my riding saddle, and my Interest in a certain negro man by the name of Ruben in the possession of James Woodruff to him and heirs for ever.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary Daniel, my land whereon I now live, with all the ballance of my property of every description (not heretofore given) to her and her heirs forever.

Item 4th and lastly I now nominate and appoint my beloved wife Mary Daniel my whole sole Executrix to this my last will and testament.

In testimony I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this sixth day of October 1827.

To all whom these presents shall come Greeting:

Know ye, that on the fifth day of November in the year of our Lord, One thousand eight hundred and twenty seven the last will, and testament of Henry A. Daniel late of said County, deceased, was exhibited in open Court, and in Common form of law, proved and admitted to record, a Copy of which is hereunto annexed, and administration of all and singular the goods, chattles, and Credits of said deceased, was granted to Mary Daniel the executrix in and by said will named and appointed, she having first taken the Oath, and performed all other requisites required by law, she is, by Order of said Court, and by virtue of these presents, legally authorized to administer the goods, chattles, and Credits of the said deceased, according to the tenor and effect of the said Will and testament. & according to law. And she is hereby required to render a true and perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, chattles, and Credits of the said deceased, and appraised and returned to this Court according to law, and to render a true and correct account, to the said Court, of her actings & doings, yearly, and every year until her administration is fully Completed. Attest the honorable Simon Morris one of the Judges of the said Court of Ordinary, this the fifth day of November in the year of our Lord eight hundred and twenty seven.
