

I HENRY B. Gibson of the County of Taliaferro and State of Georgia, knowing that it is appointed once for all to die, and being much afflicted, - but of sound and disposing mind - Do make this my last, will and testament (Wt.)

Item 1st I Give and bequeath unto Augustus H. Gibson in addition to what I have before given him the sum of Twenty two hundred Dollars in money.

Item 2nd I Give and bequeath unto Springer Gibson in addition to what I have before given him - the sum of Eleven hundred Dollars in money.

Item 3rd I Give and bequeath unto Robert C. Gibson exclusive of what I have heretofore given him, the sum of Eleven hundred Dollars in money.

Item 4th I Give and bequeath unto Augustus H. Gibson and Springer Gibson in trust, for Blanche Gibson Delex G. Gibson's wife and the Children of Delex Gibson in addition to what I have before given, the sum of Eleven hundred Dollars in money - and also One half of my interest in five Tractions lying on the Chattahoochee River - the place whereon I now live (the Tractions not yet being yet paid for.)

Item 5th The Trust estate created by the fourth item is not to be enjoyed by the person for whose benefit the Trust is created, until Delex G. Gibson accounts to and settles with my Executors. Whatsoever may be found to be due, which may in some degree be ascertained, by reference to an account, I have made out against him subscribed with my name, and attested by Swetston Claffin in the event of the refusal of Delex G. Gibson to pay the amount found to be due against him, then and in that case, the Trust estate shall revert to my estate.

Item 6th I will and bequeath unto Denton M. Gibson and Denton M. Gibson in trust, for Peter L. Gibson, all the residue and remainder of my estate both real and personal, whosoever to be found. The Trust shall determine and cease, whenever Peter L. Gibson the (Cesque que trust.) shall desire it and the property to become his.

Know Ye, that on the Tenth day of March in the year of our
Lord, Eighteen hundred and thirty one the Last Will and Testa-
ment of Henry B. Gibson late of said County deceased, was proved,
and approved, and allowed of; the said Henry B. Gibson having
in his lifetime, and at the time of his death, diverse goods, rights,
and credits, within the County aforesaid; by means whereof, the appro-
bation of allowing of his Testament, and the power of granting
the administration of all and singular the goods, rights, and credits
of said deceased, and his Testament, any manner or way concerning
to the said Court does of right belong: They have, therefore, granted
and Committed the administration of all and singular, the estate
aforesaid, and his Testament unto Augustus B. Gibson one of
the nominated Executors of the said deceased, in his Last Will
and Testament, being first sworn on the Holy Evangelists
of Almighty God, well and faithfully, to administer, and make
a perfect inventory of all and singular the goods, Chattles, and credits
of the said deceased, and exhibit the same in to the Clerk of the

to be recorded, on or before the Tenth day of June next ensuing, and
to render a just and true account, Calculation, and reckoning thereof
