Beatie to be paid over to her upon her Marriage or arriving at the age of Twenty one year My will is should my said Grand daughter Ann M. H. Beatie die before Marriage or arriving at the age of Twenty one years the Estate hereby given to Henry M. Todd in trust for said Grand daughter Ann M. H. Beatie shall belong to him individually. In the event of my being a fortunate drawer in the present Land and Gold Lottery now drawing in Millidgeville I desire the same to be sold & the proceeds thereof to be equally divided Among my three Grand Children here named, Henry M. Todd Aphiah B. Fawcett & Ann M. H. Beatie for them to share equal & share alike
