Item 1<sup>st</sup> After the payment of all my just debts, I will and bequeath to my beloved daughter Frances A Tilly all my wearing apparel, silver ware, china and crockery, glass and potteryware.

I also will and bequeath to my said daughter Frances A Tilly all the property of every kind & description including lands horses mules cattle sheep ~~horses~~ hay household and kitchen furniture plantation tools carriages buggies waggon carts cotton wheat corn oats and all other kinds of provisions and fodder and all money notes accounts and evidences of debts and every other species or kind of property both real and personal that may be due and coming to me from the estate of my late husband James Peck Sr -

Item 2<sup>d</sup> I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my beloved daughter Frances A Tilly executrix to this my last will and Testament
