I Sealbourn Dosey of the County of Taliaferro and State of Georgia being in a low state of health but of a sound and disposing mind - have thought proper to make this my last will and testament revoking all others - 1st It is my will and wish that all my just debts be first paid out of my Estate by my Executors hereinafter named - 2 It is my will further that after my Debts are settled, that the balance or remainder of my property whatever that may be shall be equally divided between my two brother, Lemuel Dosey and William Dosey Share and Share alike except such property as is otherwise disposed of by this will 3rd It is my will that my sister Rebecca Pearson, shall have a certain tract or lot of Land that I drew in Muscogee County known in Plans of said County by lot Number one hundred and fifty five (155) in the fifteenth District (15) in full of her share of my Estate 4th I hereby constitute and appoint Lemuel Dosey and William Dosey my Executors to this my last will and testament signed, sealed and Delivered in in presence of
