To all to whom these presents shall come - Greetings

Know Ye, That on the sixth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven the last will and Testament of William J. Kelly late of said County, deceased, was exhibited in open Court, and in Common form of law proved and admitted to record, a Copy of which is herewith annexed; and administration of the estate, real and personal, of said deceased, was granted to Sarah Kelly the executrix in and by said will named and appointed, she having first taken the oath and performed all other requisites required by law this is by Order of said Court, and by virtue of these presents, legally authorized to administer the estate, real and personal, of the said deceased, according to the tenor and effect of the said will and testament, and according to law, and she is hereby required to render a true and perfect inventory of all the estate, both real and personal, of the said deceased, and have the same appraised and returned to this Court according to law, and to render a true and correct account to the said Court, of her actings and doings, yearly, and every year, until her administration is fully completed
