in order to be Recorded in it before the first
Monday of May next ensuing and to render a just
and true account calculation and reckoning of the said
Administration when thereunto required and to ordain
depute and constitute you the said A. S. Collins admini-
strator of all and singular the goods chattels and credits
of the said deceased Within Hon. Matson H. H. H.
Ordinary for Tattnall County the first day
of March A.D. 1858
