guardians are by Law Required to do for the said
Person in respect to his maintenance, education in suitable
boarding lodging & clothing, and provision for his health
things as may be suitable to the circumstances and
Interest of the said Person during his minority and
to true and faithful Accounts of his Guardianship
Render accordingly to Law
