belonging desiring that the goods rights and credits
of the said deceased may be well and truly as
justly converted and well disposed of
hereby Grant unto the said Henry Ginssey
full power by the tenor of these presents to ad-
minister the goods chattels and credits of the said
deceased which to him in his life time and
by his death ^{he} belonged and to act for him due
for recovery and receive the same and to pay the
debts which the deceased owed which
for forth as his goods chattels and credits will
extend according to their rate and order of law
being first sworn on the Holy Evangelist of the
God to make a true and perfect inventory the
