

A Record of John Thompson, Executor of a deceased

Georgia. The Honorable the Court of ordinary
Tattnall County for the County and State aforesaid
To John Thompson.

Whereas Thomas S. Thompson late of the County and State
aforesaid deceased and intestate having whilst he lived and
at the time of his death real and personal estate within
the County and State aforesaid by means whereby the full
disposition and power of granting the administration of
all and singular the real and personal estate of the said
deceased and also settling the account, valuations and
 reckonings of the said administration and a final settle-
ment of the same to the Court is manifestly known to
belong I desiring that the real and personal estate of
the said deceased may be well and truly administered, or-
dained and well disposed of he hereby grant unto the
said John Thompson full power by the force of these
present to administer the real and personal estate of
the said deceased whilst he lived in his lifetime and at
the time of his death and belong and to ask long suit
for recovery and to save the same and to pay the debts
in which the deceased stood obliged so far forth
as his real and personal estate well extended according
to their rate and manner of law being first sworn
on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God to make
a true and perfect inventory thereof and to exhibit
the same unto the Court of ordinary aforesaid in
June 1861

order to be accounted on or before the first meeting of
July next ensuing and to render a just and true
calculation and rendering of the said administration
when the Court aforesaid can and do deem expedient and
constitute you the said John Thompson administrator
of all and singular the real and personal estate
of the said deceased

By William W. Thompson, Clerk of the Court of said County to John Thompson, returning
Saying it has been represented to me that Thomas B. Thompson
late of said County deceased died intestate and whereas
it is further represented to me that the said Thomas B. Thompson
at the time of his death was possessed of considerable real
property and whereas it is further represented to me that there
is great danger of waste of the said estate for the want of
an administrator being had in the same and
whereas I have the power of granting temporary letters of
administration to him, a person to whom the same
shall be made known that I William W. Thompson Clerk
of the ordinary of the County aforesaid have this day appointed
you the said John Thompson administrator of all and singular
his personal and chattel rights and credits of the said Thomas
B. Thompson deceased temporarily and until you shall otherwise
be mandated by the Court of administration on said estate to which
I will take care of said business from now to the said and personal
estate of said Thomas B. Thompson in terms of the law to the
use benefit and behoof of those who have a right therein
and you the said John Thompson will take into your hands
and possession and keep safe from any waste all the goods
and chattel rights and credits of him the said Thomas B. Thompson
deceased until you and legal administration may be had and
then you do make or cause to be made a true and perfect
inventory of all and singular his personal and chattel rights and
