 such publick this as my last will and testament hereby beathing
 all others. I Item 1st It is my will and desire that my body be decently
 buried and the expenses of my burial and last illness be paid out of my
 Estate. I Item 2nd It is my will and desire that if the real Estate
 conveyed by me by deed to trust to Dwight H. Perry should not be sufficient
 to pay my just debts that the balance of my said debts be paid out of my
 Estate not embraced in said trust deed.
 I Item 3rd It is my will and desire that after the pay ment of my
 debts that may remain unpaid, if there should be any, that the balance of
 my Estate personal and real be divided Equally except as is here in after
 provided here between my Mother & Brother George F. Swift except as
 Whom I desire to have no part of my Estate my sister in law
 to receive and Equal share of my Estate with the Brother except George
 F. Swift. I Item 4th I do will and bequeath to my Sister Mrs. Mary
 Perry three hundred dollars more and a bene and equal share of distributions
 share with the legatees of unpaid the legacy to be paid after the debt
 of my Estate are paid. I Item 5th For as much as my wife has abandoned
 me in health and in sickness It is my will and desire that the Children
 have no part of my Estate personal or real and I hereby request my
 Executor to resist any claims and debts may set up to the same -
 I Item 6th I hereby appoint my Nephew Dwight H. Perry executor
 of this my last will and testament and request him to retain
 J. B. Huntors Esq of Knoxville to manage and attend to any business
 of my Estate and to pay said Hunter out of my Estate an
 reasonable compensation for his professional services & also direct
 my said Executor to use my horse and buggy in attending to my
 business without charge and after he is through with the estate
 business said horse and buggy to be his own property - and my Executor
 may sell my property at private or public sale as may be most to the
 interest of said the Estate
 I Item 7th If my Nephew D. H. Perry should not qualify as an Executor
 under this my will then I request my friend William Allen to
 qualify and act as executor thereof. If neither D. H. Perry or
 William Allen should not as executor or be a major then I request
 my friend Morgan Ingram to act as executor under this
