publish this my last Will & Testament.

Item the 1st I desire that at my death that my body
be buried in a manner suited to my condition in life.

Item the 2^d. I give & bequeath to my Daughter Nancy
A Grant, my negro man Lewis during her natural life &
in the event she Nancy A Grant should die without ^{children} of her
body, my further desire is that said negro Lewis should go
to & become the property of my Grandsons Charles
Grant the oldest son of Thomas A Grant & Jacob

A Grant the oldest son of William S Grant equally
share & share alike.

Item the 3^d. My further will & desire is that all the rest of
my property of every description both real & personal &
unimpaired, shall go to & become absolutely the property of
my said daughter Nancy A Grant.

Item the 4th. To my said son William S Grant
I give nothing they having already received their full
share of my Estate.

Item the 5th. I name my witnesses James H. Winchell
& Daniel W. Miller my executors in testimony
whereof I have hereunto set hand & affixed my seal
this 5th of March 1858 Signed Sealed & delivered
