

Georgia ³ In the name of god I mean I Will Name ² Edwards
Fayor County ² of the State and County aforesaid being now in body
but of sound and disposing mind and memory do make this my
last will and Testament in manner and form as follows.

Item 1st It is my will and desire that my just debts of every description
be first paid.

2nd I give to my son Thomas M. Edwards my negro boy Martin two
years old, worth six hundred & fifty dollars and I desire he takes him
in possession before there is any division of my property I want him
to pay a reasonable hire for him until that time.

3rd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mariah Ann my
property of every description until my youngest child arrives
at fourteen years of age. I give her during her natural life the
lot of land on which their house at 40 one hundred and twenty
in the twenty fourth district of Auglaize County now say in a acre
also seven and thirty fifth acre out of said lot in the same aforesaid
land I bought of George H. Pease. It further is my will that if my operations
thrive proper they are at liberty to till the place or lands their own and purchase
else where with the proceeds the said lands to my wife & children. It is further my
will and desire that my wife shall have the sum of one thousand dollars down and
about one hundred dollars with my children. And in this event my Executor shall
proper to the peers of the land I now own & purchase else where it is my desire
that my wife have as much of the land purchased during her natural life as she
needs for a home and cultivation.

4th When my youngest child arrives to the age of fourteen years to do my
will that my property be left off and each child that is of age above thirteen
part thereof belonging to the minor children with my wife part of
the same proper to kept together as common property and as one asset
to whom it shall and so continue until it is all parcel out

5th Item. It is my will that what property my daughters may get be
enjoyed by them during their natural life and after their death to go to their
spouse. My daughter Henrietta H. M. Henderson should she die before
her husband it is my will that she have the sum of two hundred dollars during her
life & after his death to the wife of my daughter Henrietta.

6th I do hereby nominate and appoint my beloved wife Mariah Ann
& my sons James H. and Michael G. Edwards Executors to this my last will
and testament. The aforesaid ⁷ & ⁸ items are included in this will.

8th In the event that the boy master that I give to my son Thomas H. Edwards should die before he should become in possession of him that all the heirs should suffer an equal share in the lot.
