make and publish this my last Will and Testament hereby
Revoking all Wills by me at any time heretofore made
And I Commit my Soul to God who give it and
my Body I desire to be buried in a decent and
Christian Manner and my worldly Estate I
dispose of as follows

1st I give to my Son George, W. the place I
live on which is Lot of Land No Twenty nine
(29) in the 1st District of Telfair County

2nd I give to my Son George, W. my House Bill
and thirty head of my Home Stock of Sheep

3rd I direct that the Remainder of my Property after
paying my just debts be equally divided between
the rest of my Heirs

4th I direct that my beloved Wife Mary be the
Executrix of this my Last Will

Item first I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my Circumstances

Item Second I do hereby direct that my just debts be paid with as little delay as possible
Item third I give bequeath and devise to my grand Children Lenore, M. Campbell John A. Campbell Andrew J. Campbell Robert M. Campbell William F. Campbell and Mary, F. Campbell one half of Lot of Land number 77 (more or less) in the Tenth district of Telfair County containing one hundred one and one quarter acres more or less with all the rights, Members and appurtenances to said Land, in any wise appertaining, or belonging free from all charge or Limitation whatever to their own proper use benefit and behoof for ever with full power to dispose of the same at any time I also give and bequeath to my said Grand Children Lot of Land number 78 in the Tenth district of Telfair County containing two and one half acres more or less given in the said unreserved manner. I also give and bequeath to my said Grand Children in the same unreserved manner the farming
