in the 8th Dist of Vaits County by the No: 1448 also all
my Stock of Cattle Horses hogs Sheep &c forty heads of Cattle
more or Less and there increase also three heads of Horses and
there increase also fifteen heads of Hogs and there increase
together with all my House hold and Kitchen furniture
and farming utensils to wit) Cows Plows and all
other farming implements to wit) one yoke of oxen
Sugar boiler Mill and all fixing Belonging there to
to have and to hold the Same to her for and during her
natural Life and after her death the above described
Property to be equally divided between her four
Daughters to wit Mary A. L. Shaw and Augusta Ann
Webb Martha A. M. Webb Christian, C. Webb bearing
their Lifetime unless they attempt to sell or dispose
of it then and then there Claim to Vaits Property
is null and void and the Vaits Property to be equally
divided between the other Vaits who have not
attempted to sell or dispose of their Part and further
more I will State in this my Last will and Testament
that I have heretofore given to my two sons William
H. H. Webb and P. H. A. Webb their proportionable Part of
my Estate and they are not to inherit any of my Estate
mentioned in this Will Signed sealed and declared

Selfair County } Clark William Clark and Martha

Clark were together present on the
fourteenth day of June in the Year eighteen hundred and
Eighty four at the Dwelling of J. Wesley Clark there of
said County now deceased said Resarah Clark being
in her last sickness that a very short time before
her death not more than four days being as appeared
to us in full possession of her mental faculties the
said Resarah Clark Fair County Wills 1857-1890
and in presence of each other to bear witness that
it was her Will and desire that all her Property
Personal after paying her just debts after her
death should go to and vest in her Children
William Clark my Son I give to him Two heads of
Cattle Martha Clark my daughter I give to her
three heads of Cattle Mary Resarah my daughter
I give to her three heads of Cattle Sarah Ann
Clark my daughter I give to her three heads
of cattle my Mule and Cart and Household
and furniture and all the Remainder I divide
Equally between them and she also express-
ly called us to bear witness that her said
Husband J. Wesley Clark should be the
Executor of her will then and there verbally
declared this 14th day of June 1884
