I may have made

I Give First - To my wife Leticia and her children
I give and bequeath three squares of land in the
Eight district of Jeffair County known and distinguished
by the plan of said district as numbers three
hundred and eighty four four hundred and five
and number four hundred I also give to her and
her children the following negro slaves to wit
A man Margaret and her child Betty and
any further increase of Margaret Caroline
and her children Butler and Miley and any
further increase of Caroline a cart
Yoke of oxen two horses and Cattle
all my house hold and kitchen furniture
plantation and other tools and all
Cattle and Hogs and other

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of sheep and all the pasture and lands
and my sugar mill and I

All the balance of my property of which I may
die possessed I give and bequeath to my older
set of children that is the children of my first wife
to be equally divided among them after the pay-
ment of my just debts and after a year's provision
of Corn meat and is set apart and given to my wife
and children

I do hereby appoint my wife and William Studston
Executor and Executor to carry out the provisions
of this my will and Testament.

Testament - 20th June 1886.

First I revoke and annul the 1st I have of said
will so far as relate to the property given

That I bequeath to my wife Lucretia during
her life all of the property left to her & her children
& at her death to be equally divided between
her children also I give in the same like
manner to my wife Lucretia two mules & one
Waggon & one Miller.

Further I desire & bequeath that if any of
my wife Lucretia's children should die leaving
no child or children then & in that case that
property to be equally divided between the rest
of the children Whomever or in life by this codicil
January 6th 1862.
