and desiring to arrange all my business
in a Christian manner do make this my
last will and testimony revoking all other
wills, or parts of wills, whether verbal or written
and leaving to my wife and my children a good
English education and several hundred dollars
each of property consisting of cattle land
and horses & the sum of one thousand five
hundred dollars each and over having in
any benefit directly or indirectly from any
of my children and myself being well able
to support them freely with the exception of my
Grand Son James W. Harrell who is deaf and
deformed and I further do hereby give
to my deach wife the property of my kind
for his own use and benefit forever.

2d I give to my son Jarvis W. Williamson
one thousand dollars & my death provide
my effects will reach about as much
3d I appoint my daughter Margaret A.
Harrell my executrix to carry this my last will
and testament into effect. This October 7th 1881
