Testament Item 1st I desire and direct that all
my just debts be paid with out delay
Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my son George
the four negroes to wit Caroline Hannah Katy and
Jenny and the children thereof and family of negroes
may have property which come by my first wife
his mother and the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars
Reserving to my self the right of giving him
an additional amount of property at some
future day should I feel so disposed and
feel that it would be consistent with my duty
to my other children

Item 3rd I give to my daughter Sallie Wife of
John Ryals the sum of Five Hundred Dollars

Item 4th I give to my Daughter Nancy
Wife of Henry Warrell the sum of Five Dollars
Item 5th I Will and wish that the balance of
my Property of all kinds whatever that may
be possessed of and not otherwise disposed
of both Real and Personal Lands negroes
Horses mules stock of all kinds money
nails &c House hold and Kitchen furniture
we shall at my death be equally divided
between my Wife Louisa and my children
Mary Wilson Harriet Lewis and Richard
and any other child or children the may
have by me

Item 6th I hereby constitute my Wife
Louisa Executrix and my brother C
Wilcox Executor of this my Last Will
Testament this 30 March 1857
