Cotton be set a side for the payment of my
debts.

Item 3rd I give to my wife Hester Ann the Lot of
Land Number (116) One Hundred and fifteen with
all the improvements on said Lot One pair Horses
and one Bay Mule Five Cows & calves four four
year old Steers all my Buggy & Ship Chest &
Oxen Buggy and all my farming utensils
also all my ^{Telfair County Wills 1857-1890} ^{www.georgiapioneers.com} stock in Lot of Land
Number (131) One Hundred and thirty one

The two other Lots of Land being and being in the
8th District of said County and State

Item 4th I give to my two daughters Mary C.
& Leathem C. jointly Lot of Land Number (116)
One Hundred and fifteen Steers five (95)
and thirty one (91) One Solid Chest and all
my Cattle except Five Cows & calves and
four four year old Steers

Item 5th I do hereby appoint my friends John
M. Roy and Jacob H. Collins Executors to this
my will.
