Item first I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my Circumstances.

Item second, I direct that my just debts be paid with as little delay as possible.

Item third I give bequeath and devise to my grand Children Senors, A. Campbell John A. Campbell Andrew J. Campbell Robert W. Campbell William F. Campbell and Mary, F. Campbell one half of Lot of Land number 17 (more or less) in the Tenth district of Telfair County containing one hundred one and one quarter acres more or less with all the rights, Members and appurtenances to said Land, in any wise appertaining, or belonging free from all charge or Limitation whatever to their own proper use benefit and behoof for ever with full power to dispose of the same at any time I also give and bequeath to my said Grand Children Lot of Land number 18 in the Tenth district of Telfair County containing two and one half acres more or less given in the said unreserved manner. I also give and bequeath to my said Grand Children in the same unreserved manner the farming

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utensils used in and belonging to said plantation
 of every description what ever and one black
 mare Seventeen years old one gray Mule nine
 years and Seventy-five Head of Cattle Mare or
 Less Marked with Crop and flower deluce in
 each ear branded with (C) all my stock of
 Hogs Marked with crop flower deluce in each
 ear all my House Hold and Kitchen furniture
 belonging to said plantation all without reserve
 or Limitation.

I therefore do constitute and appoint my son
 James Campbell and Suckies McLean Executors
 to this my Last Will and Testament this
 November 10th 1875
