my said children I hereby appoint Mrs. Nancy
Macey and Mrs. Jane Johnston of Banks County
State of Georgia Trustees for my said children I do
nominate & appoint M. N. McKee Executor of this my
Will & direct that he turn over to said Nancy Macey
Jane Johnston as trustees the property given to my
children by this will as soon as practicable and
the money arising from the sale of my other personal
be turned over to her or them as soon as she
is all paid the above and foregoing verbal
