Item 1st I intend this will to be a final disposition
 of my estate. I hereby reserve all rights that
 I may have in my land.

Item 2nd I wish my executors namely
 John M. Roy and Jacob H. Clavin as before
 as provided in my deed to have all my just
 debts paid before they pay my present crop of
 cotton to set a side for the payment of my
 debts.

Item 3rd I wish my wife to have the Lot of
 Land in Section (16) One Hundred and fifteen with
 all the improvements on said Lot One year Horse
 and one Bay Horse Five cows & calves four
 year old Steers all my traps & Trap-Catch
 & one Buggy and all my farming utensils
 also all my share and interest in Lot of Land
 Section (16) One Hundred and fifteen.

The two other Lots of Land in said and lying in the
 8th District of said County and State.

Item 4th I give to my two daughters Mary C.
 & Rebecca E. jointly, Lot of Land Section (16)
 One Hundred and fifteen. Thirty five (35)
 and thirty one (31) One third part and all
 my cattle except Five cows & calves and
 four year old Steers.

Item 5th I do hereby appoint my friends John
 M. Roy and Jacob H. Clavin Executors to this
 my will.
