 and bequeath a certain of my Horse & spurs all  
 I have and hold the same with unconditional right  
 of disposition

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> To my beloved Daughter in Law M. A.  
 E. Worney I give devise and bequeath all my bed  
 Room Furniture also one Parlor Suit of furniture  
 with the unconditional right of disposition  
 Item 3<sup>rd</sup> To my Grand Daughter that is to say  
 all Children of my Son W. E. Worney now in  
 Life or that he may hereafter have I give devise  
 and bequeath all of my Silver that is all of the  
 Silver Ware of which I am now possessor  
 the same to remain in the possession of my Son  
 W. E. Worney and his Wife M. A. E. Worney until  
 my said Grand daughter shall marry and then  
 be Equally divide among them and give  
 them as Bridal presents

Item 4<sup>th</sup> To my Grand daughter Emmaron  
 W. Worney I Give devise and Bequeath my  
 gold Pocket containing the Libens of her  
 Grand Father and Mother together with the  
 Chain there to attached

Item 5<sup>th</sup> To my Grand Daughter Annas W. W.  
 Worney I Give devise and bequeath all my  
 Bridal jewelry and one set of her ornaments  
 Buttons

Item 6<sup>th</sup> To my Grand Children that is to say  
 the Children of my Son W. E. Worney now

I give & bequeath

Item 6th To my Grand Daughter Emma Living  
one Pearl Breast Pin and the Remains of my  
jewelry

Item 7th To my Grand Children that is to say the  
Children of my Son W. E. Living now in Life  
or that may hereafter be born I give and bequeath  
all the Remainder and residue of all my property  
both Real and Personal and hereby appoint and  
Constitute my Son W. E. Living or he or he for my  
Said Grand Children all the property contained  
in this item to be kept together by my Said Son  
during his Life with power to use the proceeds  
or to sell the same and to invest the proceeds in  
similar kind of property and at his death  
his Wife or, if Living to use the same power during her  
Widowhood

Item 8 I desire that my Son W. E. Living do provide  
for my Mother and I being a Home during his Life  
so long as they can conveniently be supported and then  
my Said Son is to furnish my Said Brother such  
Means as he is able to afford

Item 9th I hereby constitute and appoint my  
Wife Mrs. E. Living Executor of this my Last will and  
Testament

Item 10th I direct that my Body be Buried in the  
City of Atlanta by my Will and in witness whereof  
I the Said Emeline Summarow Living to this my  
Last Will and Testament have set my hand and  
Seal this 14th day of October 1898

Selfair County 3, 18th day of April 1880 being at the time in  
her last sickness and in her own habitation and dwelling

for more than ten days previous to said time and free  
from any legal disability which occurred on the 18th day of  
April 1880 in the presence of the following witnesses  
to wit Eligio G. Belmont, Isaac McShanabbs and  
Saler Ryals did utter and make the following  
Verbal Will to wit I give all my house hold and  
kitchen furniture to my three children to wit John  
A. Johnston Samuel S. Johnston and James Johnston  
I desire that all my other property both Real and  
Personal of all descriptions what ever be sold as  
soon as practicable and after paying off all my  
Just debts the proceeds of the same to be given to  
my said children I hereby appoint Mrs. Nancy  
Massey and Mrs. Jane Johnston of Banks County  
State of Georgia my Executors for my said children I hereby  
nominate & appoint M. W. McKee Executor of this my  
Will & direct that he turn over to said Nancy Massey and  
Jane Johnston as trustees the property given to my three  
children by this will as soon as possible and that  
the moneys arising from the sale of my other property  
be turned over to her or them so soon as the same  
is all sold the above and foregoing Verbal Will  
Commenced to Writing this 3rd day of April 1880
