I Robert B. Coolidge of the County of Russell in the State of Georgia being of sound mind and memory and understanding the importance of this fact and to my own life, do therefore make or give public and declare this to be my last Will and Testament that is to say First after all my lawful debts are paid and discharged the residue of my estate both Real and Personal I give and bequeath and dispose of as follows To wit.

To Mary Coolidge the Dowry of Bolton in Lunnady Carolina consist of my father Elliot Coolidge &c &c all my interest in my Father's Estate and all evidence of debts due to me by my Father or other claims that I may have on the said Estate. Second to my property in the State of Georgia after the payment of my debts to be equally divided between John B. Vanover of the County of Russell and State of Georgia and Caroline & Crawford wife of William H. Crawford of Arkansas County and State of Arkansas.

Likewise I make constitute and appoint John B. Vanover to be executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills by me made.
