Item Third — I desire and direct that the whole of my Estate both real & personal consisting of lands stock of every kind & household furniture & all other property I may have to hold by my Executor as soon as the Law will permit and the money arising therefrom to be divided between my beloved wife & three youngest children in the manner following To wit: My beloved wife Emma Ezart to have one share and each Child to wit: Simon P. Ezart & Rebecca Ezart to have the each that is to say I desire my said wife Emma to have the one tenth of all the money arising from the sale of my property and the remaining nine tenths to be equally divided amongst my three youngest children already named to wit: Simon & Charles & Rebecca Ezart.

Item Fourth — As I have already given to my son William D. Ezart Nancy Johnson & Martha Mills Mary Blum and my son John A. Ezart a portion of my property herebefore of more value than I have given my younger children I do not feel that I am in any way bound to make any provision for them in this my last will & testament To my daughter Sarah Bond Howard wife of Abner Howard I give and bequeath the sum of ten dollars to be paid to her or her heirs by my Executor.
