and her issue, at the death of her Mother, Margaret Gay, the property
given in Item Second.

I do give I send, I give and devise that all my just debts be paid
without delay by my beloved wife Margaret Gay or if she unwilling my
Creditors should be delayed of their right especially as there is no
necessity for delay.

I give I send, I give and devise to My Daughter Caroline Laigler the plantation
whereon I now live embracing Five Hundred Acres more or less
and comprising the following Lots to wit, Number Two hundred and
Nine (209) Two hundred and Forty (241) and the Western half of Lot
Number Two hundred and thirty (239) all situate being and lying
in the Seventh district of said County together with all my household
and kitchen furniture and also my Negro Boy Neely about
25 years of age.

I then 2^d I give to my young daughter, Elizabeth W. Wren, all my household and other personal property and all my clothing, books and papers in cash.

I then 3^d I desire and direct that the personal property of my estate be divided amongst my children, both sons and daughters, share and share alike, the portions of my deceased son James A. Knight taking a child's part. Hence.

I then 4th It is my will that the property falling to my daughter in the distribution of my estate be for their sole and separate use and exempt from the debts liabilities or contracts of their husbands, either present or future.

I then 5th I constitute and appoint Edward B. Knight, William Knight and Caroline Knight executors of this my last will and Testament.

Powell County } In the Name of God I, I then
I Charles W. Kelly son of said State and County being of ad-
vanced age, and knowing that I must shortly depart this life, deem
it right and proper to do as regards my family and myself that I
should make a disposition of the property with which a kind pro-
vidence has blessed me, do therefore make this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking all others heretofore made by me.
I then 1st I desire and direct that my body be buried in
a decent and Christian like manner suitable to my condition
in life. My soul I trust shall return to rest with God who
gave it.

I then 2^d I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid
without delay by my executors hereinafter appointed so I am
unwilling my creditors should be delayed in any right.

I then 3^d I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife Mary
fractional lot number two hundred and six in the second district
of Powell County containing twenty acres more or less with all
the rights appurtenant and appurtenances thereto belonging. I also
give and bequeath to my wife one hundred and fifty dollars
more or less to be paid to her at her death.
