

Wishes of Georgia. In the name of God Amen
Wandolph County. I David Knight of said State and
County being of sound mind and knowing that I cannot thereby
defeat the laws then in force and proper both as respects my family
and myself, that I should make a disposition of the property which
which a kind Providence has blessed me, is therefore make this my
last will and Testament hereby mentioning all others may be me.
First Will. I give and devise that all my just debts be paid with
out delay by my Executor herein after to be appointed by me or I
am committing my Executor shall be delayed in this their right.
Second Will. I give bequeath and devise to my beloved wife
Barbara Ann Knight the plantation which I previously purchased
from Ephraim Collier containing four hundred and a few more or less
situated in the North District of said County and also the planta-
tion which I heretofore purchased from Lewis Gregory a portion of
which last mentioned plantation is situated in the North District
of said County and the remaining portion is situated in the Eleventh
District of said County containing four hundred and five acres more
or less also Lot of Land Number Four Hundred and nine in the same
District of said County and the east half of Lot Number Four Hundred
and Forty One in said last mentioned District with all the rights mem-
bers and appurtenances to said lots and parcels of Land and plant-
ations as above described in anywise belonging free from all
charges or limitations whatever. To her own proper use benefit and
 behoof forever with full power to dispose of the same at any time pre-
sents or by will or otherwise at her death as she may think proper, I also
give and bequeath to my beloved wife in the same undivided manner
the following named Negro Slaves. P. W. B. George a man slave about
thirty five years of age and his wife Nancy about thirty five years of
age, Washington a man slave about thirty four years of age
and his wife Caroline about thirty five years of age and their two
children viz. Edward a boy about seven years of age and Isaac a boy
about three years of age. Tom a man slave about thirty years of
age and his Malinda about thirty five years of age and their two children
viz. Carter a girl about nine years of age and Caroline about seven years
old William a boy about twenty years of age. Phillip & Peter each
about eighteen years of age Nelson and his wife Ellen each about
twenty four years of age, and their three children Tobias a boy about
eight years of age, Shepherd a boy about five and
Will and his wife Laura each about twenty eight years of age and
their five children Arnette a boy about twelve years old Peter a
girl about seven years of age, Wesley a boy about five years of
age, and their three children each about three years of age. I also
give old, also six mules and two horses such as she may choose
from all my stock of mules and horses and eight hundred and twenty
of land and eight thousand pounds of fodder and also all my household
and kitchen furniture. I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife

scrip in the same manner in and at the sum of five thousand
Dollars in cash

Third Item. I give bequeath and devise to my son David
David S. Haigler, James M. Haigler, Elfred S. Haigler, George
Henry M. Haigler, William S. Haigler and John M. Haigler
all the remaining portion of my landed estate which is not bound
for bequeathed and devised to my beloved wife with all the rights
member and appurtenances to all the land which I may be
fully possessed of, at my death, free from all charge or limitation
whenever to their own proper use benefit and behoof forever.

I also give and bequeath to each of my said sons, the sum of
Five thousand Dollars in cash. I also give and bequeath to my
son George Haigler my negro man named Parson about twenty
eight years old.

Fourth Item. I give and bequeath all the residue and remain-
ing portion of my property of every kind and description which
has not already been given bequeathed and devised in this my
will to all my children to wit: David S. Haigler, James M. Haigler,
Elfred S. Haigler, George Haigler, Henry M. Haigler, William S. Haigler
and John M. Haigler, Ann Matilda Haigler wife of Charles R. Haigler,
right Rachel E. Ogier wife of Jacob Ogier, Harriet Sweet wife of
James L. Sweet, Ann Elizabeth Christie wife of Benjamin Christie
and Caroline Haigler to be equally divided share and share alike
conditioned that all that portion of my property which my said
Daughters may receive in their distribution share shall not be in
any wise subject to the debt liabilities or disposition of their present
or future husbands.

Fifth Item. I hereby devise and direct that all my estate both
real and personal be kept together until all the cash legacies be
in specie paid and paid off, and discharged out of the first monies
arriving from the proceeds of my farm. And I hereby appoint my
brother David S. Haigler, and Elfred S. Haigler and my son in law
Benjamin S. Christie Executors of this my last will and Testament
this the 2nd day of April 1852.
