 cows I also give my youngest daughter about three years
 old four negroes to wit three Leiby Mary & Cinthia I also
 will to my wife the plantation that we now live on & all
 the hands during her widowhood & when she ceases to be my
 widow then the plantation & hands to be equally divided
 among my children Also she will the use of it to my wife
 during her widowhood - This is my last will & testament in
 the name of God amen. In testimony whereof I set
 my hand in end
