Terrell County } I, Elijah A. Terrell, of said State and County
being of a sound age but of sound and disposing mind and memory
witness, that I must shortly depart this life turn it right and proper
both as respects my relations and myself, that I should make a disposi-
tion of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me, I do
therefore make this my last will and Testament hereby revoking and
annulling all others by me heretofore made.

First, I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and a
Christian like manner, suitable to my circumstances and condition
in life. My soul I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it, and
I hope for salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed
Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Secondly, I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid with-
delay by my Executor herein after named and appointed.

Thirdly, It is my will and desire that my executor shall as soon
after my death, as far as possible, cause to be sold to some good
and honest person my negro Slaves herein after named, To-wit:
Amira and her children, Tom, Edmund, Frank, and Aaron and
proceed immediately to distribute the money arising from the sale
thereof as herein after directed.

Fourthly, It is my wish and desire, and I hereby give hypothecally
unto my beloved Sister Mary Ann Thompson the entire and third part
of all the money arising from the sale of my before named
negro Slaves and I hereby direct my Executor to pay the same
down to her or her legal representation as soon as he can effect
a sale and receive the money suffering nothing that can be
to occasion any delay whatever.

Fifthly, The remaining two thirds of the money arising from the

Sale of my negroes here before named, I give and bequeath to my
 Brother George Butler and Simon Butler to be paid to them by my
 Executors as follows To wit: each one of my Brother Abraham
 to have and receive immediately the sum of One Hundred Dollars
 And no more until all the sum coming to the third of the money is
 exhausted, and in case of the death of one of my above named
 Brothers it is my wish that the One Hundred Dollars here by given to
 him shall be paid to my Executor to my Sister Rosa Ann Thompson
 in the stead of my brother dying first, and in case of the death of
 my two brothers, and my sister Rosa Ann Thompson surviving them
 then and in that case it is my wish and desire that my Executor
 should immediately to pay over to my sister Rosa Ann Thompson
 all the money and effects remaining in his hands the whole and
 the One third part of the money from the sale of my negroes, I
 hereby give and bequeath to my belov'd sister Rosa Ann Thompson
 to do with and dispose of as she may wish all given without any
 limitation or reserve

Signed at Newby Comblute and appoint my friend Benjamin
 Roberts Executor to this my last will and Testament this May
 15th 1861.
