and publish the following as my last Will and Testament hereby
disposing and committing all other wills heretofore made by me.

First I desire that after death be left over to me my body to be
buried in a decent and christian like manner suitable to my circumstances
as in life.

Second I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid by my
Executors hereafter appointed with as little delay as circumstances
as will permit.

Third I desire and direct that my Executors hereafter named
keep all my Estate together and control and manage it for the use of
my beloved wife and my children during their minority or until they
become of age.

Fourth I desire and direct that as soon as practicable after the
death or marriage of my wife all my Estate Real and Personal be
divided between my children then in life the Representatives of my
child or children of mine that may have died share & share alike.

Fifth I constitute and appoint my friends George Sale and
Ephraim Mitchel Executors of this my last Will and Testament hereby
directing and empowering them to sell dispose of or change and buy
change any property which by Commitment they may agree to be nec-
essary for or advantageous to my said Estate and which will promote
the interest of my wife and children.
