Pheney Five hundred dollars in fee simple to be paid to her
out of my Estate by my Executor

Item Third — I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Ann
A. the residue of my property both real & personal consisting of
a tract of land in Columbia County known as the Stollard tract
containing about three hundred & eighty-eight acres. Also a tract
of land in said County late residence of Mrs Elizabeth Meyer
also a tract of land in Habersham County containing two

Twenty and fifty acres also a tract of land in the County containing
two hundred & two & one half acres also all of my negroes about
July in number my household & kitchen furniture horses & carriage
tools & accoutrements and every other article of property that I am entitled
to or entitled to in any own right in any manner whatever to have
hold & enjoy in his own right in full complete without any restriction
or reservation whatever with full power to sell give or dispose of
by deed in any manner at any time and to any person what-
soever as fully and completely as I could were I in life.
Item Fourth — I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved
wife Amanda H. executrix of this my last will & testament
this 23 July 1857
