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all the said bequestes to furnish her equal in proportion to what
received from said estate.

Item the Eighth. I desire and direct that if either wife Richard
or John Parker should die without issue or a wife then the prop-
erty so entitled shall be divided amongst the other bequestes in pro-
portion as I do now, without my estate.

Item the Ninth. I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife
Mary Ann J. Executor and my worthy friend Joseph Parker John
Parker, and Samuel Morris Executors of this my last Will and
Testament and if the said Samuel Morris should so die
executing this will then I hereby appoint the most eldest of his
brothers which may be then living this 20th day of August
1860.
