I Randal S. Jordan of the State
of Georgia

return to the Seat of War in Virginia, and knowing the
uncertainty of life and being desirous to make a disposition
of the property with which I am blessed, I have
made do now make and publish this my last will and
Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore
made

Item 1st. I wish and desire and so directing Execution
herein after named to pay all my just debts as soon
as the same can be done.

Item 2. I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife and
Nephew Sarah and Joseph White Children of my
Sister Lodowick White all of my property both
real and personal to wit: Dick a negro man
aged fifty years, and the undivided interest of land
which myself and my Brother Moses Jordan from
Chasee and comes in Partnership at the time of
his decease, also about one Hundred Head of
Hogs, together with all my notes accounts or other
evidences of debt which I may have at my decease.

Item 3rd. In case of the death of either one of my
above named Wife or Nephew death, It is my
will that the other or surviving one shall have
all the above described property in full and
in case of the death of both of them, then and in
that case it is my will and desire that my Sister Lodowick
White shall have all the property willed to my said
Wife and Nephew.

Item 4th. I hereby nominate and appoint my
son-in-law Eli C. Hill as Executor to this my last will
and Testament.

In Testimony Whereof I the said Randal S.
Jordan have to this my last will and Testament
set my hand and Seal this 19th day of January
1864
