I Randal S. Jordan of the State of Georgia do hereby certify that I am now in the State of Virginia and knowing the uncertainty of life and being desirous to make a disposition of the property which in the Providence has been mine do now make and publish this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all other wills by me heretofore made

Item 1st. I wish and desire and so direct my Executor herein after named to pay all my just debts as soon as the same can be done.

Item 2. I give and bequeath unto my beloved Wife and Nephew Sarah and Joseph White Children of my Sister Lodovico White all of my property both real and personal to wit: Dick a negro man aged fifty years and the undivided interest of land which myself and my Brother Moses Jordan from Chace and comes in Partnership at the time of his death also about one Hundred Head of Hogs. Together with all my notes accounts or other evidences of debt which I may have at my death.

Item Third. In case of the death of either one of my above named Wife or Nephew death, It is my will that the other or surviving one shall have all the above described property in full and in case of the death of both of them then and in that case it is my will and desire that my Sister Lodovico White shall have all the property willed to my said Wife and Nephew.

Item Fourth. I hereby nominate and appoint my Son-in-law Eli C. Hill as Executor to this my last will and Testament.

In Testimony Whereof I the said Randal S. Jordan have to this my last will and Testament set my hand and seal this 19th day of January 1864
