consider most beneficial to my estate.

I will and bequeath my entire estate during his natural life or until he
shall die without issue. Item 2nd. That in case my wife Elizabeth should
die again I then desire that she should have and hold all that portion
of my property which she is entitled to from her Father's Estate.

Item 3rd. All the remaining portion of my personal property and bequeath
to my dear son to be equally divided among
Item 4th. I do hereby appoint my wife Elizabeth my sole Executor
of this my last will and Testament.
